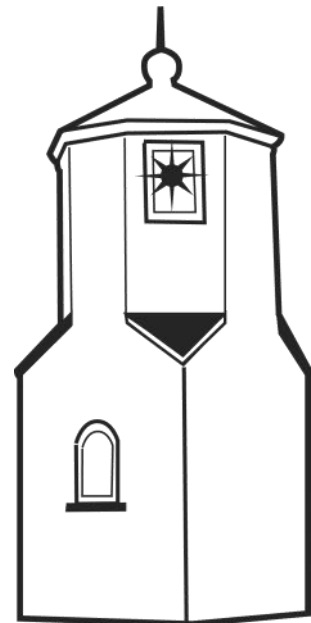
June 4, 11, 18, 25 • DISCOVERY BIRD WALKS

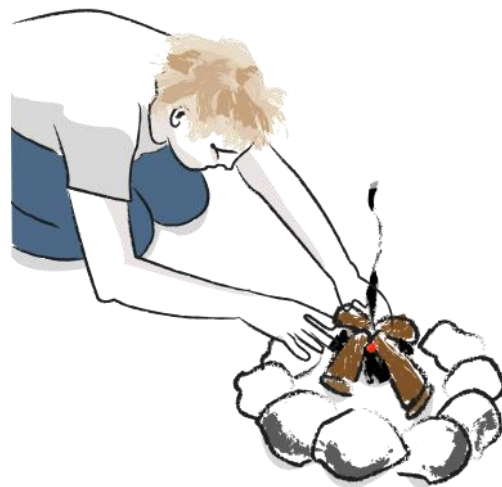

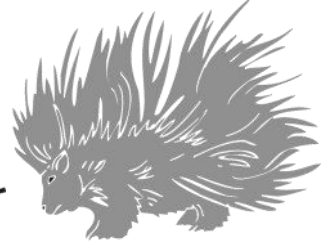
